Dr Langstein founded the Center for Restorative, Cosmetic, and Implant Dentistry in Chesapeake, Virginia in 1990 and while there focused on comprehensive dental treatment plans with an emphasis on aesthetics and implants. In 2004, Dr Landstein joined the Westchester Dental Group in White Plains, NY, and has continued this tradition. Memberships include the American Academy of Cosmetic Dentistry, The American Dental Association, and the Academy of Osseointegration. Dr Langstein has achieved Diplomate status in the International Congress of Oral Implantology. Dr. Langstein has lectured extensively on dental implants, speaking for local study groups and major international meetings for the ICOL. He has also given talks on the restorative aspects of implant dentistry, focusing on prosthetic solutions and treatment planning for dental implant systems. 
